7.B Pool Financial Reports through January 13, 2022 Receive and File

Mr. Newton presented the financial reports through January 13, 2022. Mr. Newton noted that the Pool Director has obtained an office at City Hall, and was working to update the financial reports to be presented in pivot table format which would provide budget projections for the boards review at future meetings.

Boardmember Gallagher asked about the HLVRA Sustainability Fund. Mr. Newton noted that the HLVRA has 3 funds, the Sustainability Fund (534) is a fund that is set aside for maintaining existing facility and facility maintenance. An annual \$10,000 transfer to the cash balance of this fund is the goal of the HLVRA and a budget is not loaded for this fund until a project is identified. The second HLVRA fund is the Pool Improvement Fund (535), this fund is used for adding new amenities to the facility. The Operations Fund (536) is the daily operations for the pool which has an annual budget loaded for operations use. Discussion occurred about fund balances within the County financials.

Boardmember Riggs asked if the pool needed to be drained would that be an eligible project for the Sustainability Fund. Mr. Newton noted that project could from either fund, and staff could bring back to a future agenda what fund would be appropriate for that project expense. Mr. Newton noted that resolutions were passed at the creation of these separate funds that outlined intended use of monies and that information would be included in the staff report.

The three accounts are Fund 534 HLVRA Sustainability, Fund 535 HLVRA Facility Improvement and Fund 536 Operations/General. The 534 HLVRA Sustainability Fund was adopted by Resolution No. 19-34 and the 535 HLVRA Facility Improvement fund was adopted by Resolution No. 19-33 at the September 17, 2019 HLVRA board meeting. The purpose of the 534 Sustainability Fund was to set aside money on an annual basis to accommodate for the high costs of long term maintenance at the pool facility. Some of these items could include: repaving the parking lot, re-plastering the pool, painting the building, replacing motors or a multitude of other things that will eventually need to be repaired or replaced at the facility. Prior board members were concerned that if money was not intentionally set aside for the long term needs of the facility that the financial impacts when these needs arise would have detrimental impacts to the solvency of the pool. The resolution for the 534 Sustainability Fund states that the HLVRA desires to transfer \$10,000 annually into the fund. However, the board will determine how much can be transferred each year as part of the budget process. The 535 Facility Improvement Fund is a restricted fund that allows the board to set aside money for specific projects of a significant size (over \$5000). In the past this was the fund used to earmark the diving board donations. This account may also assist in Grant matching funds if the need arises. Currently neither of these funds have an adopted budget and that is why they show a \$0 on the County Revenue Sheet. The amount currently in the accounts can be seen in the first page of the general ledger summary. The money that was set aside for projects in the previous fiscal year was adopted in the 2021/2022 Budget and is represented in account 340 "Fixed Assets" and can be seen on page 2 of the County's Budget Status Report. The 536 General Fund reflects the pools operating budget. The County's budget status report reflects a

comprehensive view of the budgetary needs of the pool as well as the city's expenditure detail report. The newly included pivot table also reflects a comprehensive overview of the 536 Budget. The pivot table is offers a literal view of expenses as while as a predictive view.

- 4) Significant Improvements for the purpose of the Pool Facility Improvement Fund is defined as projects resulting in new facilities or amenities for the HLVCP, located at 800 South ST totaling of \$5,000 dollars or more, per project.
- 5) A minimum cost threshold is set at \$5,000 per project. For the purpose of the Pool Facility Improvement Fund a project is defined as any combination of outside labor, materials, and equipment necessary to complete a Significant Improvement. All projects to be completed using the Facility Sustainability Fund must be approved by resolution of the HLVRA Governing Board.

- 6) Upon 4/5 vote of the HLVRA Governing Board the Pool Facility Sustainability Fund may be used for any purpose under the jurisdiction of the HLVRA Governing Board.

WHEREAS: The Honey Lake Valley Recreation Authority (HLVRA) is a joint powers agency between the City of Susanville and the County of Lassen; and

WHEREAS: The purpose of the HLVRA is to provide recreation facilities to the residents of Lassen County; and

WHEREAS: The HLVRA is the owner and operator of the Honey Lake Valley Community Pool (HLVCP); and

WHEREAS: Constructed in July 2017 the HLVCP facility includes an outdoor pool with perimeter fencing; parking lot; pool house, office, mechanical room; mechanical system including pumps, filters, heat exchangers, backwash tanks and other amenities; and

WHEREAS: The HLVRA Governing Board is desirous of establishing a restricted fund that can be utilized for the purpose of performing significant maintenance at the pool facility, which may include repairing and replacing equipment that has reached its useful life or has failed; and

WHEREAS: The HLVRA Governing Board is desirous of defining allowable uses for the restricted fund, setting a minimum project threshold for utilization of the fund, and providing a mechanism to override the use restriction of the fund as needed;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the HLVRA Governing Board as follows:

- 1) A Fund entitled "Honey Lake Valley Community Pool Facility Sustainability Fund" (Pool Sustainability Fund) is created.
- 2) The HLRVA will endeavor to transfer \$10,000 annually into the Pool Facility Sustainability Fund, as financial resources allow.
- 3) For Fiscal Year 2019-2020 the HLVRA will transfer \$30,000 to account for Fiscal years 2017-2018; 2018-2019; and 2019-2020.
- 4) The Facility Sustainability Fund is restricted for significant maintenance projects.
- 5) Significant Maintenance for the purpose of the Pool Facility Sustainability Fund is defined as projects for the following items performed at a cost total of \$5,000 dollars or more: As to the mechanical system of the pool facility, significant maintenance includes the repair

and/or replacement and/or servicing of established equipment necessary for the operation of the pool. As to the non-mechanical systems of the pool facility, significant maintenance includes any of the following items 1) building repair and/or appurtenance replacement of established buildings; 2) sealing, striping, repair and or replacement of established parking areas; 3) pool and pool deck repair and or replacement of established pools and pool decks. 4) any other established amenities at the HLVRP that require service to extend the useful life, or to repair or replace established amenities.

- 6) A minimum cost threshold is set at \$5,000 per project. For the purpose of the Pool Facility Sustainability Fund a project is defined as any combination of outside labor, materials, and equipment necessary to perform significant maintenance. All projects to be completed using the Facility Sustainability Fund must be approved by resolution of the HLVRA Governing Board.
- 7) Upon 4/5 vote of the HLVRA Governing Board the Pool Facility Sustainability Fund may be used for any purpose under the jurisdiction of the HLVRA Governing Board.

PRESENTED BY: Reesa Rice, Pool Director

SUMMARY: The pool director along with the HLVRA executive officer recently performed a budget analysis, during the analysis area's of potential revenue growth/revenue loss were identified within the fee schedule. The following categories were identified Summer Passes and Pool Rentals.

1. **Summer Family Pass-** It is recommended that the price for a Summer Season Family Pass increase from \$200 to \$300. Increasing the rate to \$300 will allow a family of 4 (2 adults and 2 children) to swim for free after the 15th time of attendance. Under the old rate of \$200 a family of 4 swam for free after the 10th time of pool attendance. Summer passes will be valid for the entire month of June, July and August public swim times (includes family swim). Previous Summer Pass language stated the pass was only valid during the dates of the Summer schedule and did not include the first two weeks of June nor the last two weeks of August.
2. **Pool Rentals-** The price currently charged for a 2 hour weekend block rental is \$150; whereas the price charged for pool rental times during the week is \$100/hour. The weekend block previously included 1.5 hours of swim time and .5 hour of deck time, so only the actual swim time was being charged. However lifeguards still need to be present during the deck time and customers have had an increased interest in swimming for the full 2 hours. In order to cover pool costs and align with customers needs it is recommended that the weekend Pool Rentals increase from \$150/hour to \$200/hour.
